### Philosophenweg D3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 0:30 h → 1.7 km ↕ 40 vm easy

**Starting point: Waldschenke or tourist office Ramsau**  
 The forest link between Ramsau village and Ramsau Kalm is a local classic—a flat woodland trail that connects you to numerous winter hiking routes. The Waldschenke is either the starting point or the destination. Connection options include: Panoramarunde, Kulmberggrunde, Lettenrunde, and trails heading toward Rössing.

## Cross-country skiing in Ramsau am Dachstein

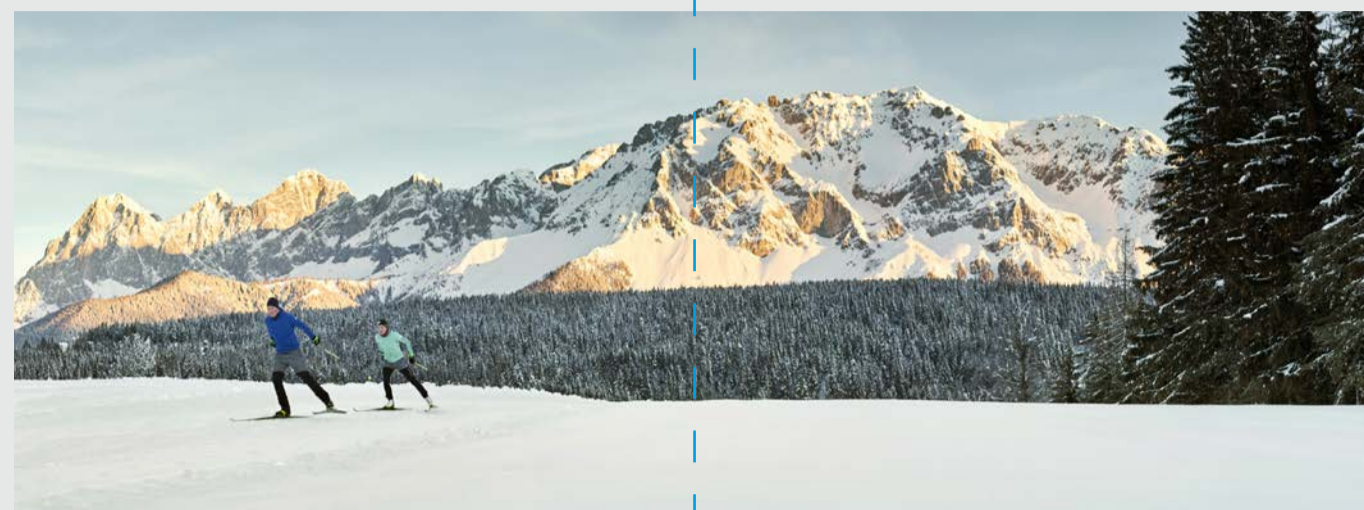
### Austria's sunniest cross-country center

The mighty Dachstein towers above you, the sun smiles on your face, and the winter air is crystal clear. It's the perfect time to pull out your cross-country skis. After all, in Ramsau am Dachstein—a true cross-country paradise—up to 220 km of perfectly groomed trails are waiting to be explored.

You'll find the wide variety of trails and all other key information about cross-country skiing in Ramsau am Dachstein clearly summarized in a dedicated cross-country brochure. You can pick it up free of charge at the information offices and from your accommodation host.

From many places to stay in Ramsau, the nearest trail is less than 300 m away on foot. Access points are also easy to reach by public transport: first take the train to Schladming, then continue with buses transported by Ramsauer Verkehrsbedriebe toward Ramsau.

### Ramsau Village D3

Snowshoe Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 2:00 h ↔ 5.5 km ↕ 220 vm easy

**Starting point: Dachstein Event Center**  
 This easy snowshoe route gives you an initial overview of Ramsau village. Starting from the cross-country ski stadium in Ramsau village, the loop takes you through the larch forest to Gasthof Edelbrunn and back. It's the perfect beginner's tour. The snowshoe route is marked on site with violet snow stakes.

### Rössingrunde E3

Snowshoe Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 2:45 h ↔ 7.3 km ↕ 250 vm moderate

**Starting point: car park "Alte Mühle"**  
 Beautiful, leisurely, and quiet snowshoe tour for sporty beginners to explore the Rössing district of Ramsau, with traditional places to stop for refreshments. From the starting point, head toward Ramsau-Rössing. Follow typical forest paths and deep, snow-covered meadows to the Bauernhofackstube Rössingerhof. For the return, follow the cross-country trail to Lodenwälder, then steadily uphill back to the starting point.

### Snowshoe Hike on the Vorberg B1 / D3

Snowshoe Hike Schladming/Ramsau  
 2:00 h ↔ 5.4 km ↕ 200 vm easy

**Starting point: hiker's info portal "Vorberg-Arnika"**  
 Beautiful forest-and-meadow snowshoe tour on the sunny Vorberg plateau. Starting from the Brandstätterhof, you head east along the so-called "Lochweg" at the edge of the forest, pass through the Wolfsschlucht to Ramsau-Vorberg, and return to the starting point via the summer hiking trail.

### Lärchenweg D3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 0:45 h → 2.3 km ↕ 200 vm easy

**Starting point: Dachstein Event Center**  
 A forest path via the Ramsbergerhof to Gasthof Edelbrunn, which connects you to the Ramsau alpine pasture area. From Gasthof Edelbrunn, you can join other tours such as the Duregsgrunde, the Almenrunde, or the Skiroute Türwand.

### Sattelbergweg E3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 0:50 h → 3.1 km ↕ 60 vm/110 vm moderate

**Starting point: Gasthof Sonnenhügel/Almstube**  
 Connection from Obere and Untere Letten to Ramsau-Rössing. A long stretch follows a forest road through the woods. Once in Rössing, you can connect to the Panoramarunde or the Lettenrunde.

### Buchenweg D3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 1:50 h ↔ 7.0 km ↕ 180 vm easy

**Starting point: tourist office Ramsau**  
 A beautiful beech-forest path between Unterer and Oberer Letten in Ramsau am Dachstein. It connects the Reitpension Brandstätter with the Kiebhuberhof and continues into the Lettenrunde.

### Rittsberg-Hut Hike C3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 3:30 h ↔ 9.5 km ↕ 100 vm moderate

**Starting point: Rittsbergbahn mountain station**  
 The combination lift (gondola-chair) now lets you enjoy culinary hiking in winter, too. Start your winter hike at the Rittsstadl, right next to the mountain station. The route leads to the Sonnenalm, and a good quarter of an hour later you'll reach the Haseralm. West of the Sonnenalm you can also visit the Wiesalmshalm. From there, the trail continues to the Rösteralm and then back to the valley station of the Rittsbergbahn.

### Rittsberg-Summit Hike C3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 1:30 h ↔ 5.2 km ↕ 100 vm moderate

**Starting point: Rittsbergbahn mountain station**  
 The summit hike starts at the mountain station of the Rittsbergbahn. From there, you hike about 20 minutes to the summit cross at an elevation of 1,682 meters, where you can enjoy magnificent views of the Dachstein massif. Continue along the winter hiking trail, which loops alongside the high-altitude cross-country trail. About halfway, you'll reach a signposted junction that points the way back to the Rittsstadl and the mountain station.



### Winter Hiking Path Weißenbach – Burgstaller – Weißenbach G3

Winter Hike Haus im Ennstal  
 2:30 h ↔ 8.0 km ↕ 280 vm moderate

**Starting point: Rittsbergbahn mountain station**  
 The summit hike starts at the mountain station of the Rittsbergbahn. From there, you hike about 20 minutes to the summit cross at an elevation of 1,682 meters, where you can enjoy magnificent views of the Dachstein massif. Continue along the winter hiking trail, which loops alongside the high-altitude cross-country trail. About halfway, you'll reach a signposted junction that points the way back to the Rittsstadl and the mountain station.

### Equipment tips for tours in backcountry terrain.

For your own well-being, as well as that of the environment and your mountain companions, we recommend preparing thoroughly for your tours and packing the appropriate equipment.

- To ensure your safety, you should always have the following with you:
- Avalanche transceiver (beacon)
  - Mobile phone
  - Shovel
  - Avalanche probe
  - First-aid kit
  - Sufficient food and drinks
  - Possibly extra clothing to change into

On the Pital, the new "Mittlerhausalm" 8-seater chairlift sets new standards: superior seating comfort with weather-protection hood, heated seats, and convenient boarding. It shortens waiting times and ensures a smooth, pleasant ascent.

At Hauser Kabling, the new 10-passenger gondola "Senderbahn" delivers a sense of pure superlative: spacious cabins, weather-protected accents, and an even faster, more direct connection within the 4-Mountain Ski Area Schladming.

Access from the valley to the Fageralm high plateau is now provided by a modern 8-passenger gondola—the Fageralmbahn. Its 55 spacious panoramic cabins ensure the highest level of risk comfort.

### Kulmberggrunde D3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 3:15 h ↔ 10.3 km ↕ 125 vm easy

**Starting point: Dachstein Event Center**  
 Starting from the cross-country ski stadium in Ramsau village, the "Schlittenweg" takes you around the entire Kulmberg via Kulm and Vorberg. This is the main loop for horse-drawn sleigh rides, which cover the 10 km circuit in about two hours.

### Kulmberg Waldweg D3

Winter Hike & Snowshoe Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 2:50 h ↔ 8.9 km ↕ 170 vm moderate

**Starting point: Waldschenke**  
 From the starting point, circle the ski jump landing area and join the Philosophenweg, which gently leads to Kulm. From there, continue either along the road or, starting at the Skitube Steiner, follow the forest path. Continue on the signed route to the Kulmbergstraße. From the Vorbergstraße, climb briefly uphill to the roller track. At the top, the forest path bends, passes Hotel Herold, and after a short stretch on the road you turn off and return to the ski jump area.

### Skiroute Türwand D3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 2:30 h → 7.0 km ↕ 530 vm moderate

**Starting point: Dachstein Event Center**  
 On the ascent, you first cross lively open meadows up to the Gasthof Edelbrunn, followed by forest sections and open terrain in the alpine area. In summer, this classic tour is known as the "5 Huts Trail" lined with traditional huts and alpine pastures that invite you to stop for refreshments. Splendid views of the snow-covered Tauern mountains and the Dachstein's south faces elevate the experience. This route offers excellent sledding and is also suitable for ski touring.

### Halserweg Sleigh Route C3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 2:00 h ↔ 7.6 km ↕ 170 vm easy

**Starting point: car park "Rittsberg Süd"**  
 From the Greimeibacherhof via the Rösteralm, a groomed sleigh track with a steady ascent leads you to the Halseralm. The fambed Kaiserschmarrn at the Halseralm is a real highlight—you have to try it. This winter hiking trail then continues via the Sonnenalm to the Wiesalmshalm (turnaround point).

### Panoramarunde C3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 5:30 h ↔ 16.5 km ↕ 250 vm moderate

**Starting point: car park "Rittsberg Süd"**  
 The main loop of the winter hiking trails is the Panoramarunde. It's the longitudinal connection across the plateau (starting in Schladming/Dachstein Road (starting at the toll station), Ramsau village, Ramsau Kalm, Vorderer Ramsau, and Rössing, and it ends at the well-known Lodenwälder in Rössing. So if you stroll across the plateau once, you've been to "every corner" of Ramsau. And, as the name suggests, this plateau hike comes with sweeping panoramas.

### Lettenrunde D3

Winter Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 2:00 h ↔ 6.1 km ↕ 210 vm easy

**Starting point: tourist office Ramsau**  
 This circular route leads over the Obere Letten to the Untere Letten and connects to the Panoramarunde and the Kulmberggrunde. Situated to the south, it crosses wide meadows and a short forest section, offering fine vantage points toward the Niedere Tauern. Starting from the tourist office Ramsau, you can choose the path toward either Obere Letten or Untere Letten. The Untere Letten route also forks, giving you a second option toward the Gasthof Sonnenhügel.

### Duregsgrunde Snowshoe Tour C2

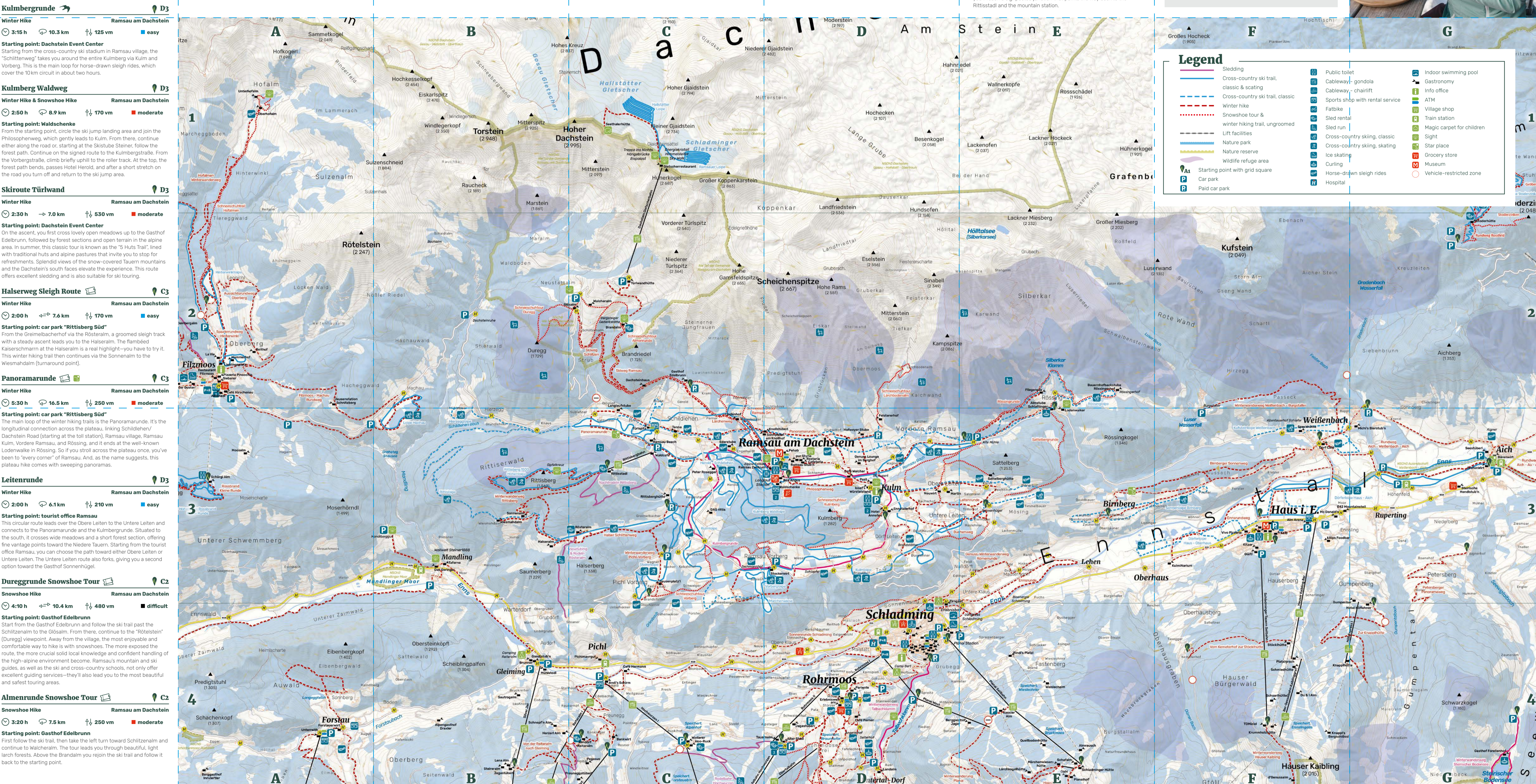
Snowshoe Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 4:10 h ↔ 10.4 km ↕ 480 vm difficult

**Starting point: Gasthof Edelbrunn**  
 Start from the Gasthof Edelbrunn and follow the ski trail past the Schlitzalm to the Ölsalm. From there, continue to the "Rösteralm" (Duregg) viewpoint. Away from the village, the most enjoyable and comfortable way to hike is with snowshoes. The more exposed the route, the more crucial solid local knowledge and confident handling of the high-alpine environment become. Ramsau's mountain and ski guides, as well as the ski and cross-country schools, not only offer excellent guiding services—they'll also lead you to the most beautiful and safest touring areas.

### Almenrunde Snowshoe Tour C2

Snowshoe Hike Ramsau am Dachstein  
 3:20 h ↔ 7.5 km ↕ 250 vm moderate

**Starting point: Gasthof Edelbrunn**  
 First follow the ski trail, then take the left turn toward Schlitzalm and continue to Walcheralm. The tour leads you through beautiful, light larch forests. Above the Brandalm you rejoin the ski trail and follow it back to the starting point.

### Winter Hike to Obertal

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 4:40 h ↔ 17.2 km ↑↓ 250 vm ■ moderate  
**Starting point: hiker's info portal, Rohrhoos center**  
Switch off and escape the everyday hustle—or simply enjoy a cozy afternoon away from the ski slopes? Then Obertal is just the place for you. This tranquil valley is perfect for glorious winter hikes.

### Winter Hiking Path Untertal

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 2:15 h ↔ 7.7 km ↑↓ 30 vm ■ easy

### Starting point: Gasthof Tetter

From Gasthof Tetter, a specially groomed and easily accessible winter hiking trail leads to Gasthaus Weiße Wand. With minimal effort, you'll enjoy the fresh air and tranquility of the enchanting Untertal. The return route goes via the Sondl-Alm, rounding out the experience with a culinary stop that invites you to take a break.

### Rohrhoosrunde to Schladingmng

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:45 h → 5.9 km ↑↓ 40 vm/280 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: hiker's info portal, Rohrhoos center**  
A varied hike from Rohrhoos to Schladingmng, lined with cozy inns and restaurants where you can warm up along the way. It's not the shortest option, but certainly one of the most charming ways to travel on foot from Rohrhoos to Schladingmng.

### Winter Loop Talbachklamm

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 2:15 h ↔ 6.6 km ↑↓ 225 vm ■ easy

### Starting point: car park "Kraiter", Schladingmng

The first section of the hike takes you through the Talbachklamm, a gorge which is especially enchanting in winter. Ice rock formations, snow-covered cliffs, and striking ice formations and cave-like visitors of all ages. From Untertal-valley, you follow the valley road up to the sunny Rohrhoos plateau. Along the route, you'll find several variant options as well as places to stop for food and drink.

### Planai West – Talbachklamm

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:20 h → 3.5 km ↑↓ 20 vm/180 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Planai West valley station**  
A scenic winter hike that begins with a short gondola ride, followed by a beautiful walk along the Spretzweg—especially sunny in the afternoons—through the Talbachklamm back to Schladingmng. This route treats you to several highlights along the way!

### Winter Hiking in Rohrhoos

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:30 h ↔ 5.1 km ↑↓ 195 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: hiker's info portal, Rohrhoos center**  
Not only summer is ideal for hiking—Rohrhoos is a hiker's paradise in winter, too. Enjoy a leisurely winter walk at the foot of the Hochwurzen and across the sunny Rohrhoos plateau.

### Sonnenrunde Schladingmng

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 3:00 h ↔ 12.0 km ↑↓ 70 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: hiker's info portal, Planai stadium**  
An easy yet extended winter hike that takes you through the mountain town of Schladingmng and, for long stretches, along the river Enns. Much of the route leads across the sunny slopes of the Obere Klaus district.

### Ennsrunde Schladingmng

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:30 h ↔ 6.3 km ↑↓ 25 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: hiker's info portal, Planai stadium**  
A relaxed winter walk that's perfect for beginners when you just want a quick outlook. The route leads from the Planai stadium toward congress Schladingmng, passes it on the right, and continues to the right-hand bank of the river Enns. You then follow the river—with virtually no elevation gain—to Lehen and back to Schladingmng.

### Relaxing Winter Hike Römerrunde

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 2:00 h ↔ 6.3 km ↑↓ 65 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: hiker's info portal, Planai stadium**  
A leisurely hike on the "sun-side" of Schladingmng, offering lovely views toward the mountain town and across to Rohrhoos and the Hochwurzen. Part of the loop follows the Hochstraße—a historic Roman road—hence the route's name.

### 4-Jahreszeiten Hiking Path

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 2:45 h → 5.9 km ↑↓ 590 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Hotel Winterer, Hochwurzen II chairlift valley station**  
A gently ascending, wide trail—mostly through beautiful high-elevation forest—leading to the Hochwurzen summit (1,852 m). You can either hike the winter trail uphill to the mountain station or take the Summit Gondola up and enjoy a relaxed walk back down to the starting point.

### Reiteralm: from mountain to valley

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 2:40 h → 9.3 km ↑↓ 610 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Silver-Jet mountain station, Reiteralm**  
From the starting point, follow the ski slope for a few meters and you'll come to the Reiteralm winter hiking trail. It leads through a beautiful forest section to the Almldorf Reiteralm and from there into along the valley via the Preunegg Road. If you like, you can then continue along the railway line back to Gleimng.

### Winter Hike Planai

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 2:00 h → 6.8 km ↑↓ 490 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Planai gondola mountain station**  
Winter hike along the Planai Road from the Planai gondola mountain station to the mid-station. Even without skis, you can enjoy the snow-covered landscapes and magnificent views on the Planai.  
**ATTENTION:** From the mountain station of the Planai gondola to the start of the Planai Road, and again shortly before the mid-station, you must cross the ski slope—exercise caution here!

### Snowshoe Tour Oberatal

**Snowshoe Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 4:45 h ↔ 17.6 km ↑↓ 360 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Rohrhoos center or Windbacherhub, Oberatal**  
This signposted tour leads from Rohrhoos into the Oberatal, where you can visit the historic nickel smelting furnace at the head of the valley. Near the Hochwurzen Gipfelbahn valley station, Sport Fritschner and Ski Lenz also offer snowshoe rental.

### Snowshoe Tour to the Gasselhöhe

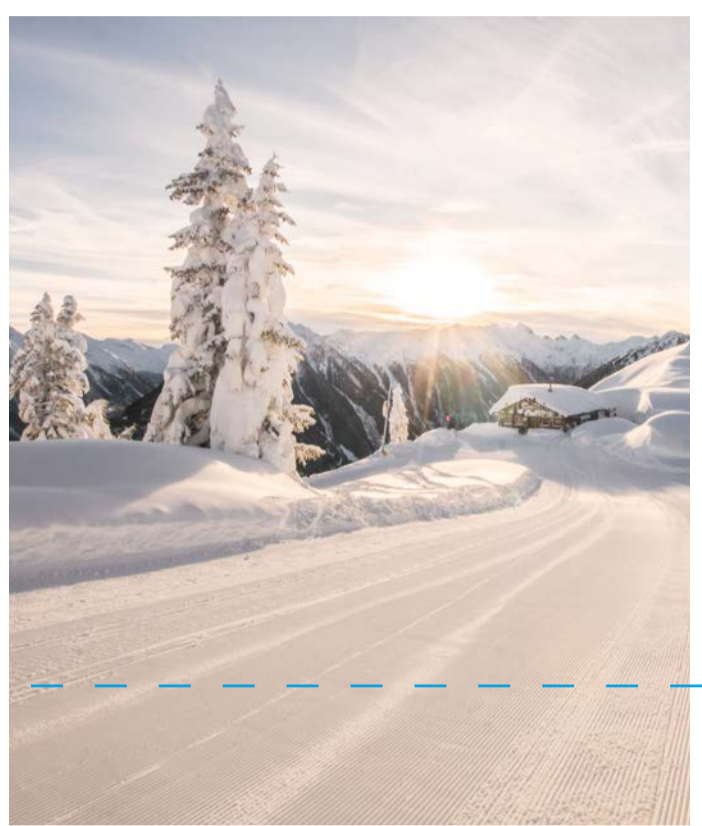
**Snowshoe Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:00 h ↔ 1.7 km ↑↓ 140 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Gasselhöhe chairlift mountain station, Reiteralm**  
From Gleimng, take the Silver-Jet gondola and the Gasselhöhe 6-seater chairlift up to the Reiteralm. From the chairlift's mountain station, set off south on snowshoes. A gentle initial climb leads to a small rise before the main ascent to the Gasselhöhe begins. At the Gasselhöhe summit cross, enjoy wonderful views of the Schladingmng Tauern, the Dachstein Massif, and the Enns Valley.

### Snowshoe Tour to the Rossfeld

**Snowshoe Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 2:00 h ↔ 3.4 km ↑↓ 275 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Gasselhöhe chairlift mountain station, Reiteralm**  
From Gleimng, take the Silver-Jet gondola and the Gasselhöhe 6-seater chairlift up to the Reiteralm. From the chairlift's mountain station, set off south on snowshoes. A gentle initial climb leads to a small rise before the main ascent to the Gasselhöhe begins. At the Gasselhöhe summit cross, enjoy wonderful views of the Schladingmng Tauern, the Dachstein Massif, and the Enns Valley.



### Rohrhooser Snowshoe Tour

**Snowshoe Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:30 h ↔ 3.6 km ↑↓ 165 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: hiker's info portal, Hochwurzen valley station**  
The Rohrhoos snowshoe tour is a snowshoe hike along forest roads and sunken lanes through the woods, as well as across the open, snow-covered meadows of the "Rohrhooser Friedl". Places to stop for food and drink include the Tauernalm and the "Alte Stadt" at Familienhotel Austria.

### Evening Sledding Fun on the Reiteralm

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:45 h → 3.8 km ↑↓ 435 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Almldorf Reiteralm/Hotel Edelweiß**  
From the rustic Hochalm—which you reach after roughly an hour and a half on a beautiful hiking trail—a 4-km toboggan run, illuminated at night, leads directly down to the Almldorf Reiteralm.

### Hopsi's Winter Hiking Path

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:00 h ↔ 2.6 km ↑↓ 115 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Planai gondola mountain station**  
This lovely, family-friendly winter hike is located in the Hopsi Winter Children's Area on the Planai. It's also ideal for meeting friends who are skiing on the Planai and then enjoying lunch together at one of the ski lifts along the winter hiking trail.

### Winter Hike Pichl-Vorberg

**Winter Hike** Schladingmng/Ramsau  
⌚ 1:20 h ↔ 7.9 km ↑↓ 220 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: hiker's info portal "Vorberg-Arnika"**  
The ideal starting point for this leisurely walk is near Pension Arnika. A wide, well-kept path offers magnificent views of the Schladingmng Tauern range. The route hugs Röbelsalm, Halseisalm, Sonnensalm, and Wiesmaldalm—together with the stunning vistas and beautiful winter scenery are sure to make your day. The return follows the same route.

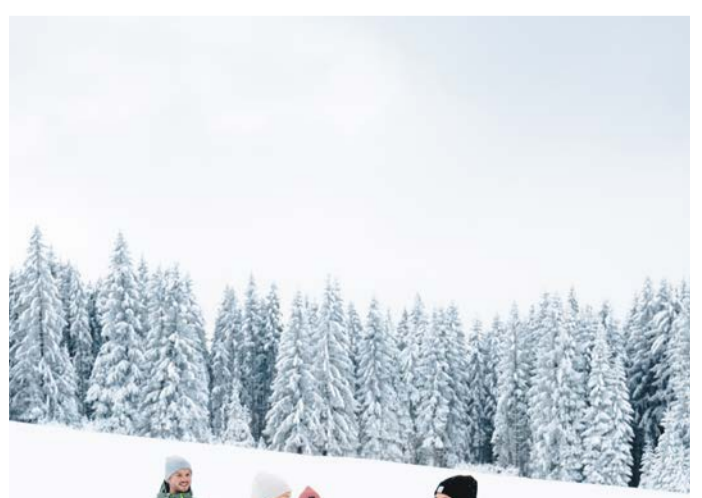

**Winter Hike** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 1:30 h ↔ 5.1 km ↑↓ 50 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Erlebnisfreizeit Haus im Ennstal**  
Experience an unforgettable hike in the beautiful, snow-covered Enns Valley. Cleared winter trails lead from the town of Haus across the suspension bridge to Weißenbach (and vice versa).



### Snowshoe Tour Oberatal

**Snowshoe Hike** Schladingmng  
⌚ 4:45 h ↔ 17.6 km ↑↓ 360 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Rohrhoos center or Windbacherhub, Oberatal**  
This signposted tour leads from Rohrhoos into the Oberatal, where you can visit the historic nickel smelting furnace at the head of the valley. Near the Hochwurzen Gipfelbahn valley station, Sport Fritschner and Ski Lenz also offer snowshoe rental.

### Petersberger Panoramaweg

**Winter Hike** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 2:00 h ↔ 5.9 km ↑↓ 260 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Algenhof on the Petersberg**  
Drive up by car to the Algenhof area on the Petersberg. From there, the trail ascends gently, passing traditional mountain farms such as Schwarzkogler, Poser, and Pözl, until you reach the endpoint at the Schwaighof on the Petersberg. Return the same way you came.

### From the Kemeterhof to the Stöcklhütte

**Winter Hike** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 1:30 h ↔ 5.3 km ↑↓ 175 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Kemeterhof on the Oberhausberg**  
Above the town of Haus, at around 1,200 m above sea level, you can enjoy a leisurely winter hike through snow-covered forests and then comfortably meet up with skiing friends or family at the Stöcklhütte. Return the same way you came.

### Winter Hiking Path Hauser Kaibling

**Winter Hike** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 1:30 h ↔ 4.0 km ↑↓ 60 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Tauern Seilbahn mountain station**  
From the Tauern Seilbahn cable car mountain station, walk past the Krummhütte and Tölketal toward the Kaiblingalm—directly to the new d'Genussalm. Once there, relax on the large sun terrace with Kaiserschmarrn and hot chocolate while soaking up the magnificent views of the Dachstein Massif. Return via the same route and take the Tauern Seilbahn cable car back down to the town of Haus.

### Winter Hiking Path Steirischer Bodensee

**Winter Hike** Aich  
⌚ 1:00 h ↔ 3.1 km ↑↓ 30 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: car park Steirischer Bodensee, Seewigtal**  
This leisurely walk takes you by the easiest route to the natural jewel of the Steirischer Bodensee. Once there, the Forstlehen invites you to stop in for a bite. It's a worthwhile destination year-round.

### Loop Trail Aich – Weißenbach – Aich

**Winter Hike** Aich/Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 2:00 h ↔ 7.6 km ↑↓ 80 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Aich village square**  
A leisurely walk along low-traffic roads to the charming village of Weißenbach, adomed with loving details. Use caution on the road back toward Enns, as it sees somewhat heavier traffic—but this in no way detracts from the beauty of the hike.

### Au-Loop

**Winter Hike** Aich  
⌚ 1:25 h ↔ 5.0 km ↑↓ 90 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Aich village square**  
From Aich's village square, stroll across the level crossing and follow the road into the riverside meadows (Au). Continue over the Enns bridge, through the underpass beneath the federal highway to Assach, and from there back to Aich.

### Ennsrundweg

**Winter Hike** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 1:30 h ↔ 4.3 km ↑↓ 50 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Erlebnisfreizeit Haus im Ennstal**  
An easy hike along the river Enns to Oberhaus, then back to Haus im Ennstal via a side path. Be sure to include a visit to the gothic church Margarethenkirche (built in 1500) in Oberhaus—entrance via the south portal. The church is open during the day, and the detour is well worth it for culture enthusiasts.

### Birnberger Sonnenweg

**Winter Hike** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 3:00 h ↔ 8.0 km ↑↓ 190 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Grundnerhof on the Birnberg**  
A leisurely winter walk on the sunny Birnberg plateau, with magnificent views of the ski peaks of the 4-Mountain Ski Area Schladingmng. You'll also pass numerous picturesque farmsteads along the way.

### Winter Hiking Path Knaaplhütte

**Winter Hike** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 2:30 h ↔ 8.2 km ↑↓ 380 vm ■ moderate

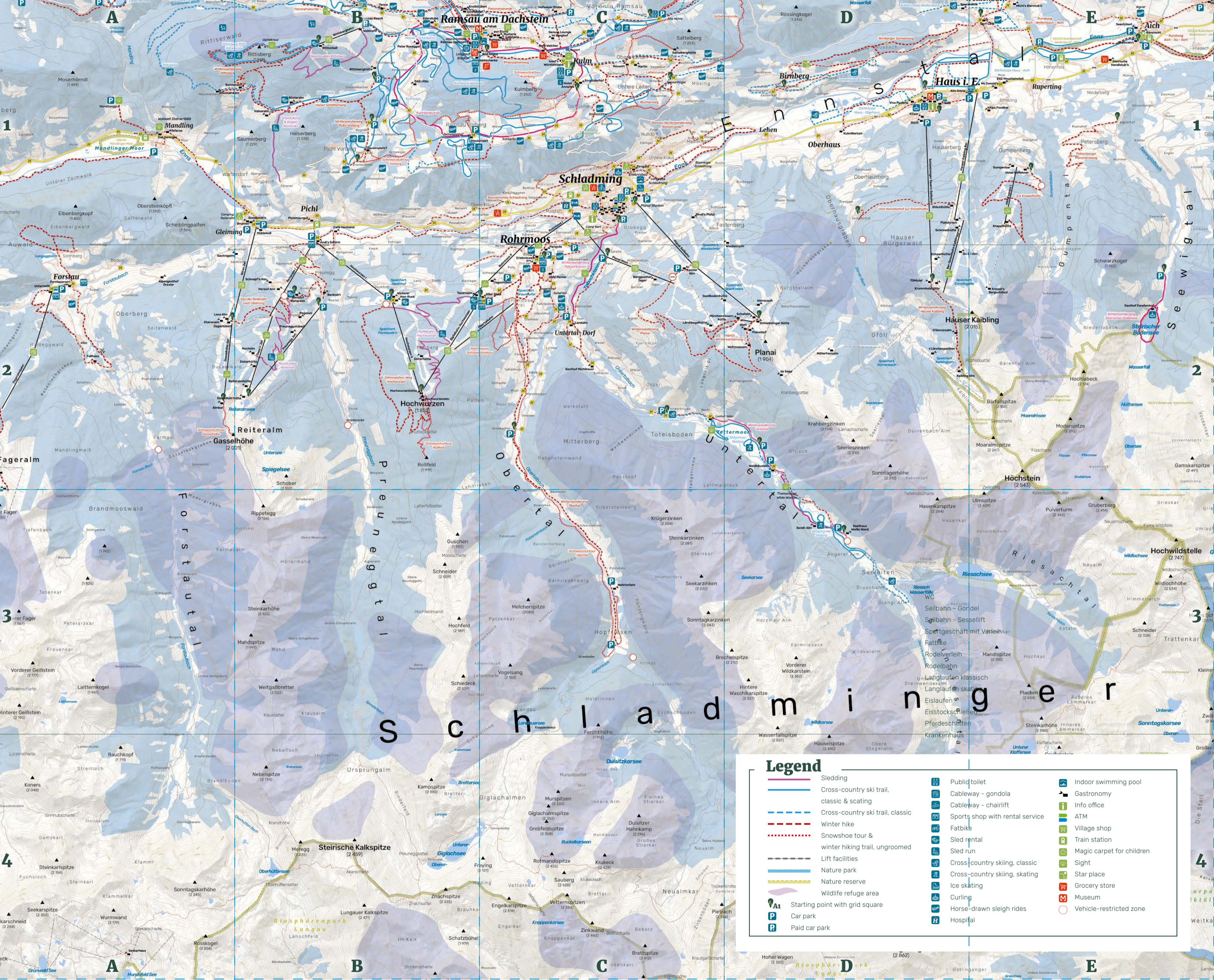
**Starting point: Hotel Höflehner on the Gumpenberg**  
Starting from the Natur- & Wellnesshotel Höflehner on the Gumpenberg, follow the trail uphill, passing the red deer enclosure and the ski lift to the Knaaplhütte. Alternatively, take the "Hof-Express" chairlift and then follow the trail downhill back to the Natur- & Wellnesshotel Höflehner. Return the same way you came.  
**ATTENTION:** The route crosses the ski slope in places.

## Cross-Country Ski Trails

### Kristalloipe in the Untertal

**Classic** Schladingmng  
⌚ 2:30 h ↔ 13.5 km ↑↓ 105 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: cross-country info portal "Hinkerbrücke"**  
The Kristalloipe in the Untertal is a classically tracked cross-country trail and a true insider tip for Nordic skiers. It's an easy loop with three short, moderately challenging climbs. Running time and again along the crystal-clear waters of the Untertalbach, this is—without exaggeration—one of the region's most beautiful trails and an absolute delight to ski. On cold winter mornings in particular, the trail's name reveals its meaning.



### Almenrunde Skating Trail

**Skating** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:00 h ↔ 5.5 km ↑↓ 30 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Sulzberg bridge or Gasthaus Weiße Wand**  
The skating trails in the Untertal are among the easier skating routes in the Schladingmng-Dachstein region, as most sections run over very flat terrain. The "Almenrunde" skating trail takes its name from the many alpine huts on the Untertal valley floor and offers several opportunities to stop for alpine cuisine.

### Steirerloipe Vorberg

**Classic & Skating** Schladingmng/Ramsau  
⌚ 1:15 h ↔ 5.0 km ↑↓ 95 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: hiker's info portal "Vorberg-Arnika"**  
The Steirerloipe features both a skating lane and a classic track, with a direct connection to the Ramsau trail network—putting up to 220 km of top-notch cross-country skiing at your feet. After a meadow loop near Hotel Steierhof and a figure-8 loop in the Oberhomer/Untermohr area, the trail continues past the starting point to the opposite side of the road. After a short section, you can either complete the Steirerloipe or switch onto the Halseisloipe.

### Tettermoor Skating Trail

**Classic & Skating** Schladingmng  
⌚ 0:40 h ↔ 4.0 km ↑↓ 20 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: car park, "Tettermoor" lookout tower**  
From the starting point, head down-valley toward the "Tettermoor". Right at the beginning—as well as on the opposite bank of the Untertalbach below Gasthof Tetter—two lovely loops are groomed. Most of the trail runs over flat terrain with no significant climbs or descents. The only moderately challenging section is the climb up to Gasthof Tetter and the subsequent descent from there into the Tettermoor.

### Almenrunde Skating Trail

**Skating** Schladingmng  
⌚ 1:00 h ↔ 5.5 km ↑↓ 30 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Sulzberg bridge or Gasthaus Weiße Wand**  
The skating trails in the Untertal are among the easier skating routes in the Schladingmng-Dachstein region, as most sections run over very flat terrain. The "Almenrunde" skating trail takes its name from the many alpine huts on the Untertal valley floor and offers several opportunities to stop for alpine cuisine.

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### Village Trail Haus – Aich

**Classic & Skating** Aich/Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 2:00 h ↔ 13.7 km ↑↓ 60 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Erlebnisfreizeit Haus or Grafenwirt in Aich**  
You can start in either Haus or Aich. From each entry point, simply follow the trail and the signposts. Between the trails, in the Weißenbach area, you'll need to walk a short stretch through the "Lärchschenchen". In a few other sections, you may also have to cover a few meters on foot.

### Kufsteinloipe Weißenbach

**Classic & Skating** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 1:00 h ↔ 5 km ↑↓ 20 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Bierstub'n pub**  
Cross-country skiing on the "sun-side" of the Enns Valley in the village of Weißenbach, with views of the snow-covered ski mountains of the Schladingmng Tauern. Near the Bierstub'n pub in Weißenbach a gentle, slightly ascending trail leads past the village toward Rössing (Ramsau). After the turnaround point, either head back to Weißenbach or continue to the starting point. From there, you can add another loop heading southeast.

### Sonnenloipe Birnberg

**Classic** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 1:10 h ↔ 5.3 km ↑↓ 70 vm ■ moderate

**Starting point: Grundnerhof on the Birnberg**  
Dense spruce forests give way to clearings and meadows—pristine nature and quiet await those who savor the experience. Starting from the Grundnerhof on the Birnberg, head east to the turnaround loop near the Pichel/Forsterhof. From there, return toward the village center, continue behind the farmsteads to Birnberg West, and once again use the turnaround loop to head back into Birnberg.

### Village Trail Haus – Oberhaus

**Classic** Haus im Ennstal  
⌚ 0:50 h ↔ 5.1 km ↑↓ 45 vm ■ easy

**Starting point: Erlebnisfreizeit Haus im Ennstal**  
Discover part of the beautiful Enns Valley along the village trail from Haus to Oberhaus. Starting at the trailhead, the cross-country track takes you across the Schladingmng-Dachstein golf course to Oberhaus. There, you complete a loop and return to the center of Haus.

### IMPORTANT: Cross-country skiing in the valley is only possible with sufficient natural snowfall



## Tips for a mindful approach to nature

- Check weather and snow conditions:** Caution: mountain weather can change quickly! Avoid summits, ridges, and fixed-rope sections during snowfall or storms.
- Choose the right route:** Wildlife needs peace and quiet; always use designated routes. Keep your distance from tree clusters and solitary trees above the treeline, where sensitive species like the black grouse live.
- Respect wildlife protection areas:** Do not leave the trails—especially at dawn and dusk when wildlife is active. Please also refrain from tours at twilight and at night.
- Take responsibility:** Leave no trash and help preserve the beauty of the surroundings. Keep your dog on a leash to avoid stressing wildlife. Protect young forest and avoid reforestation areas. Use designated parking areas and don't block access roads or paths.
- Travel sustainably:** For eco-friendly travel to your winter hikes and ski tours, various ski and valley buses are available. Timetables: [schladingmng-dachstein.at/buses](http://schladingmng-dachstein.at/buses)
